The time allotted for each scientific presentation will be strictly 10 minutes. Please ensure that the presenting author's telephone / fax numbers and email address are mentioned. All abstract material for papers and posters will be reviewed by a Scientific Committee. A total of 60 abstracts for papers and any number for poster presentations shall be allowed. Only the authors who are presenting the selected papers are requested to send their abstracts by 30th November, 2009 and full text by 31st December, 2009. The decision on selection of abstracts by the Scientific Committee will be final. You may submit an abstract, not exceeding 300 words.
